



# What is Chronological?

- A book that does not have the standard structure of a Yearbook (i.e. Sports, Academics), instead it is organized by weeks and divided into two sections: coverage and reference.
- The chronological section has the week by week pages while the reference section has the mugs, index, and ads sections.
- Chronological allows for more coverage, more creative design, more flexibility, and a much cleaner structure.



# Standard Structure of a Page

- The standard structure of a page is broken down based on the size of the coverage.
- The primary is the largest piece of coverage, then secondary, tertiary, and finally quaternary.
- Each level of coverage focuses on a different story that happened during that week (i.e. the primary is covering basketball but the secondary focuses on algebra).



# Division of Spreads

- Our editor and our Yearbook advisor broke down the amount of pages they wanted in the chronological section and in the reference section (which would be the index, business, and mugs sections).
- They then looked at the calendar for our school year and gave each week a certain number of pages based on what was happening during that week.



# Division of Staff

- The editor and Yearbook advisor also divided the staff into teams.
- Each team would have a team leader who was in charge of the content of the pages during their week.
- Since our staff had 25 people we broke it down into 5 teams of 5 people.

# Schedule

- Week 1 Planning – the team leader would make a calendar for the next week and assign the other members to go and take pictures.
- Week 2 Coverage – The teams would take pictures of the different events that they had been assigned during planning.
- Week 3 and 4 Build – The teams would begin to design the pages and put in quotes. The page would be finished by the last day of the 4<sup>th</sup> week.
- Week 5 Mugs – Teams would make a mugs spread that the editor would assign.
